We are proud to inform you that we now accept electronic prescriptions!

What is an electronic prescription?

An electronic prescription is a computer-generated prescription sent electronically from your health care provider directly to our pharmacy.

How does it work?

Electronic prescriptions are sent using a private, secure, and closed network. Your prescription information is not sent over the internet or as an e-mail.

What do you need to do to get an electronic prescription?

Ask your doctor to send your prescription electronically to our pharmacy. We will provide an informative flyer to their office upon request. Please have your doctor's office contact us at the number below to get started.

After your doctor has sent us your electronic prescription, please contact us at the number below to ensure we have received it. This will allow us to process your medications and ensure they are ready for pick up upon your arrival. Due to the procedure of processing electronic prescriptions, waiting times may be prolonged up to 45 minutes if you do not notify us ahead of time.

Are there any exceptions to electronic prescriptions?

Some medications will still require paper prescriptions. For example, military pharmacies do not accept electronic prescriptions for controlled substances. Also, military pharmacies do not accept faxed prescriptions.
